SELECTION CRITERIA

To qualify for a bursary, the potential applicant must satisfy the following criteria:

- 1. **Citizenship:** South African Citizenship;
- 2. **Fields of study**: intending to or pursuing an academic qualification in the built environment;
- 3. **Academic performance:** matriculants should meet the minimum requirements for enrolling for the chosen field of study.
- 4. **Enrolment at academic institution:** applicants must be eligible for enrolment at the relevant tertiary institution.
- 5. **Financial needs:** students from families with a combined annual household gross income of less than R120 000.00.

- 6. **Demography:** preference will be afforded to students from previously disadvantage groups.
- 7. **Commitment to join the South African local government sector:** signing a commitment to join the South African local government sector as an employee, candidate or experiential learner for a period of 24 months for those who shall have received MISA bursary support for two or more years; or a period of at least 12 months for those that shall have received MISA bursary support for less than two academic years.

COVERAGE

The MISA bursary shall cover registration, tuition, accommodation, meals and prescribed books.
